Coordinated Opportunities - Points Possible: 10

Safety - Points Possible: 20

Describe how the project improves overall safety. Scoring criteria cover all modes of travel and include the 4E's of transportation safety, namely: engineering, education, enforcement and emergency medical services.

Environmental - Points Possible: 20

Describe how the project improves natural and cultural resources. Scoring criteria may include projects that adhere to the FWS Roadway Design Guidelines and/or projects that reduce carbon (GHG) emissions.



Transportation Project Description Form

Access, Mobility and Connectivity - Points Possible: 15

Describe how the project expands transportation mode options or improves circulation to or within the station. Criteria elements may include improved access for underrepresented populations or alleviation of a congestion 'hot spot'.

Visitor Experience - Points Possible: 15

Describe how this project improves the quality of the visitation experience at the station. Criteria elements may include improvement of an auto tour route or vehicular pullouts for interpretation/education/recreation.
