

## NOTES:

- 1. Locate sediment filter bags in level areas (less than 5% grade) or as approved. When level areas are not available, place geotextile filter and coarse aggregate to level the sediment filter bags.
- 2. Locate sediment filter bags in areas accessible by equipment for maintenance and removal.
- 3. Insert no more than one hose in each sediment filter bag at any given time.
- 4. Inspect sediment filter bags daily. Replace bags when 50% of the sediment capacity has been reached or when there is a failure. Have spare sediment filter bags on site for replacement.
- 5. Do not permit discharge from the sediment filter bags to drain back into work or access areas of the project. Discharge onto stable and erosion resistant areas.
- 6. Do not cut or empty sediment filter bags on site. Restore the area according to Subsection 157.15.
