Construction Activities and Upcoming Work

Environmental Group completed planting willow and cottonwood pole plantings at the MP 4 ELJs. These plantings will help provide revegetation and further stabilization of the banks behind the ELJs that were built this year. Next week ICI, will install temporary construction fencing along the ELJs built this year to delineate this sensitive revegetation area. Please do not cross the fencing or park along the shoulder at these ELJs so that this vegetation has a chance to establish. This will conclude the work on this project for 2022. ICI will return in the Spring 2023 for the final season of work on this project, which will primarily consist of completing the last eight ELJs at MP 3.6 and building a precast box culvert at MP 4.5.

- ICI will return in Spring 2023 to resume work
