This work consisted of setting up Temporary Traffic Control and beginning clearing of trees at the location of the new bridge to be installed at Canyon Creek, Mile Post (MP) 10, as well as clearing of trees at the Morgan's Crossing parking area, MP 6.7.

Next week, ICI will continue clearing trees at Canyon Creek MP 10 and will begin clearing for the Engineered Log Jams at MP 4.5 & 7
