### Rock Scaling and Building a Wall

The contractor completed one Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) wall on the project. Contractors are now establishing a road to gain access to the next MSE wall to begin excavation and construction.

The sub-contractor has been scaling rock from the rock face on the West side of the Daley Rankin tunnel. Removal of the rock on the West side is nearly complete and work will advance to the East side of the tunnel. This work will take approximately two weeks to complete.



The contractors normal work hours will be Monday thru Friday 7:00 am—5:00 pm.

The **trail is closed** from the intersection of East Beach road and Joyce Piedmont road to Camp David. No public access will be allowed.
