

SPRUCE RAILROAD TRAIL SEGMENT B

Project Description

Constructing 1.8 miles of trail from McFee Tunnel (Devils Punchbowl) to West of Daley Rankin tunnel then, paving 3.8 miles from Camp David to the Lyre River Parking lot.

Building a Wall, Scaling and Excavating

The contractor prepared subgrade and started construction on the second Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) wall also, rip rap was placed at the bottom of the wall. The sub-contractor continues to scale and remove loose rock from the rock face around the tunnel and loose rock material was excavated from within the Daley Rankin tunnel. Once this is complete they will begin the process of installing dowels in the tunnel to help stabilize it.
