The contractor completed one Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) wall and is now excavating for the second one. They are placing the excavated material on the trail to build it up to grade in some of the low areas.

The sub-contractor is continuing to remove loose rock from the slope on the East side of the Daley Rankin tunnel and from the tunnel walls. Once complete, they will begin the process of installing bolts into the tunnel to help stabilize it.



The contractors normal work hours will be Monday thru Friday 7:00 am—5:00 pm.

The **trail is closed** from the intersection of East Beach road and Joyce Piedmont road to Camp David. No public access will be allowed.
