- The roadway reconditioning will be completed on August 30th.
- The Red Bridge Campground is closed and equipment and materials mobilization is underway.
- Construction of the diversion on the south fork of the Stillaguamish River will begin on Saturday, August 1st.
- Construction of the diversion and river bank armor will continue through the week-end.
- Work will continue seven days a week through approximately August 15th.
