Project Description

The North Entrance Project is the final component of the development of the Gardiner Gateway project. The project consists of a new entrance station building and two entry kiosks, a new employee bypass road, additional queuing lanes, and operational improvements to the Gardiner Transportation Center and Robert Reamer Road.

Upcoming Activities:

- Clearing and grubbing in front of Gardiner Transportation Center
- Trenching for waterline will start next week on August 4, 2020 and start at the intersection at Park and Robert Reamer Ave.
- Southbound access through Park and Robert Reamer Ave. will be closed. A single lane will be provided for Northbound traffic ONLY. Access to all the buildings along Robert Reamer will be maintained.
- Employees are encouraged to take the entrance road and come around from the other side of Robert Reamer Ave.
