

Ohana Waste Treatment Service Road
- July 23— SR 123 from 1st 5 miles from S Entrance
- July 24— Ohana Campground Entrance Road  
Ohana Ranger Station Parking A

One way traffic will be controlled with flaggers and pilot car.  
Expect delays up to 20 minutes  
Work hours will be Monday thru Friday 7:00am—5:00 pm.
