This week was a tough one as the recent fires cut off Asphalt Patch and Doolittle from entering the Park from the North. Asphalt Patch had to cancel work on Tuesday and then elected to cancel work on Friday. In between, they did some patching at Ohana's Loops B and E.

Doolittle micro surfaced the first couple miles along SR410 from the north heading south. They have also started corrective action work on deficiencies.

Next week, there will be micro surfacing on Sunrise Rd at the Entrance Station, Sunrise Point, and along Owyhigh and Frying Pan Trailheads.
