# Project Description

The North Entrance Project is the final component of the development of the Gardiner Gateway project. The project consists of a new entrance station building and two entry kiosks, a new employee bypass road, additional queuing lanes, and operational improvements to the Gardiner Transportation Center and Robert Reamer Ave.
