Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) completed the drilling pad and began drilling the Permanent Ground Anchors (PGA) this week at Abutment 1 on the south side of the river. ICI completed the reinforcing steel and form work for the second of three concrete pours for the East Anchor Blocks (EAB) on the north side of the river this week, and yesterday completed placement of an additional 28 cubic yards of concrete.

For the coming week, drilling of the ground anchors will continue on the south side of the river, and on the north side, work will continue in preparation of the third concrete pour on the EAB's.

There should not be any work on site this weekend. The Salmon River Roadway will continue to be a single lane with yield signs at the crane tower, concrete barrier is installed to protect the public and project site. The speed limit continues to be 15 mph thru the work area during the 2024 Construction Season. <u>Please Use Caution</u> when traveling and be aware of oncoming traffic, during the day, the night, on weekdays and on weekends. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
