Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) has been drilling and installing casing for the Permanent Ground Anchors (PGA) on the upper row of Abutment 1 on the south side of the river this week. Crews have also been working on Abutment 2 finishing, on the north side of the river.

Next week drilling will continue on the PGA's. Work will continue on the finishing of Abutment 2. There may also be some work being performed by the U.S. Forest Service at the project site to remove a hazard tree.

The Salmon River Roadway will continue to be a single lane at the crane tower, concrete barrier has been installed to protect the public and project site. The speed limit continues to be 15 mph thru this area during the 2024 Construction Season.
