Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) completed drilling and installation of the Permanent Ground Anchors (PGA) casings on the upper row of Abutment 1. They completed installation and grouting of the PGA Tendon for the abutment 1 Performance anchor on the south side of the river.

ICI began cleanup and moving equipment off of the crane mats at Abutment 1, so they can remove the matts and prepare the subgrade around the Micro piles for the foundation in preparation for forming and tying reinforcing steel for the anchor blocks..

The Salmon River Roadway will continue to be a single lane at the crane tower, concrete barrier is installed to protect the public and project site. The speed limit continues to be 15mph thru this area during the 2024 Construction Season.
