

Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) completed base course of select fill and compaction at Abutment 1. They completed placement of Abutment 1 slab base formwork and placement of rebar at the soil nail facing wall. Crews also completed installation of drainage pipe from the soil nail wall and the anchorage vaults at Abutment 1.

Crews will not be working onsite this weekend including Monday and possibly even Tuesday because of the Memorial Day Holiday. Next week work will continue on Abutment 1 formwork and the start of piecing together the truss which is the main structure spanning the river other than the suspension cables. This work will be done at the Ebenezer staging area.

The Salmon River Roadway will continue to be a single lane at the crane tower, concrete barrier is installed to protect the public and project site. The speed limit continues to be 15 mph thru this area during the 2024 Construction Season.
