Project Description:

This project is being administered by the Federal Highway Administration Western Federal Lands Highway Division, in partnership with Flathead National Forest, US Border Patrol and Flathead County. The project will provide an improved travel surface and replacement of existing culverts on sections of Belton Stage Road, Blankenship Road, the last 5 miles of North Fork Road and Glacier Drive between Polebridge and Polebridge Ranger Station in Glacier National Park.

Surface Conditions:

Current road conditions consist of existing aggregate surface course. There are sections of rough, rutted, and ponding on roadway within work zones.

Traffic Delays:



The contractor is mobilizing in this week and will be starting work. Expect up to 30 minute delays in the work zones. Please abide by signs and traffic control on site.

Upcoming Work:



Contractor is mobilizing in this week and will be starting work. On North Fork, crews will be working to provide drainage along the roadway, clean up from winter shutdown and begin installing culverts. On Glacier Drive, work will begin on the subgrade at the Polebridge Mercantile Parking area. Work on Belton and Blankenship is currently scheduled for later in the season to repair the roadway.

Expect delays no longer than 30 minutes along the project work zones. Around the Polebridge Mercantile, follow signage and traffic control for pedestrians and parking.
