## **Construction Activities & Upcoming Work**

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) completed drilling, installing, and grouting the EAB 2A Permanent Ground Anchors (PGA), and continued drilling and casing the PGA at EAB 2B. ICI has continued placing reinforcing steel for the Abutment 1 slab and anchor blocks on south side of river.

In the coming week ICI will continue working on the drilling, installing, and grouting the EAB 2B PGA's. Testing of all of the EAB PGA's is very likely to also start this week. They will continue placing and tying the Abutment 1 slab and anchor blocks reinforcing steel in preparation for the placement of concrete in the floor of the abutment and anchor blocks. Forest Service continues working on the Salmon River Road due to mud slides on Sunday June 30th. Road is open to one lane traffic from Owl creek to project site.

The Salmon River Road will continue to be a single lane at the crane tower. The speed limit continues to be 15 mph thru this area during the 2024 Construction Season.
