## **Construction Activities & Upcoming Work**

Construction activities continue at FSR 469, Peasley Creek Road at M.P. 0.8 and M.P. 2.8. Activities include roadway excavation, Special Rock Embankment, Roadway construction and culvert cleaning. Work at FSR 469 is expected to run through out the month of July. Please be aware of truck traffic entering Hwy 14 at Peasley Creek Rd. With Construction activities continue on FSR470 Swiftwater Rd off Selway River road. Construction activities will include roadway excavation, placement of Special Rock Embankment and Gabion faced wall construction at M.P. 2.36 and M.P. 2.52. Construction at FSR470 is expected to run through the end of September 2024. Work at FSR469 was anticipated to wrap up on July 25th, however, the storm that rolled through the area on the evening of July 23rd has caused multiple blow downs and land slides along FSR469 and has blocked access to the job sites. USFS personnel are responding and will be on site as early as July 26th to clear debris and allow access to the work sites.

### **Road Closures**

FSR469, Peasley Creek Rd, will continue to remain closed from Highway 14 to FSR648, Lower Cougar Rd. Please be aware there are numerous blow downs and land slides in the area and to stay clear of the FSR469 until all construction and road clearing operations have been completed. FSR470, Swiftwater Road, remains closed to thru traffic from the Selway River to the junction of FSR653. at M.P. 2.36 of FSR470, roadway excavation has taken place and the road is not passable to any vehicles including emergency vehicles. FSR470 will remain closed to all thru traffic through at least the end of September.
