

Project Description

Utilizing Great American Outdoor Act Funding, the Lewis River Bridge project, located along the South Entrance Road, includes construction of a double span 357foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, excavation, and paving.

Work Schedule

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., 6 days a week.

The contractor completed the bridge deck concrete. They are working on old roadway asphalt removal and new roadway subgrade. Stone masonry is done on the bridge abutments and is being placed on the North MSE wall. The contractor continues work on curb concrete and bridge sidewalks.

Upcoming work includes: bridge sidewalk concrete, stone masonry, guardwall concrete, curbs, bridge approach slab concrete, and roadway subgrade. There will be some nighttime work installing culverts in the coming weeks.
