Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) completed grouting the PGA tendons and at EAB 2B. They have also completed placement of reinforcement steel for Abutment 1 slab on South side of river. ICI will be placing concrete in the slab of Abutment 1.

In the coming week ICI will continue placing and tying reinforcement steel for Abutment 1 Anchor blocks. Structural backfill will continue around the EAB's.

The Salmon River Roadway will continue to be a single lane thru the project site at the crane tower. The speed limit continues to be 15 mph thru this area during the 2024 Construction Season.

National Forest Service has extended the closure notice for the Stoddard Bridge construction project through August 2025.
