Work Schedule

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., 6 days a week.

The contractor completed the bridge approach slab concrete. They are working on bridge sidewalk and curb concrete (pictured above). Stone masonry is being done on the North MSE wall. The contractor continues excavation and grading for both parking lots.

Upcoming work includes: bridge sidewalk concrete, stone masonry, guardwall concrete, curbs, guardwall stonework, roadway grading, and the river diversion for the old bridge removal.
