Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) completed proof testing the ground anchors at EAB 2A and grouting of the ground anchors at EAB 2B. They completed fit up of the open bridge socket take-ups at EAB 2B. Work also continues on the Abutment 1 anchor block reinforcing steel and formwork.

In the coming week ICI will complete EAB 2A grouting and complete the grouting of the contingency anchor holes at both EAB 2A and 2B, and possibly install and grout the anchorhead caps of both EAB 2A and 2B. Work will continue on the reinforcing steel and formwork at Abutment 1 anchor blocks with concrete tentatively scheduled for late in the week.

The Salmon River Roadway will continue to be a single lane thru the project site and at the crane tower. The speed limit continues to be 15 mph thru this area during the 2024 Construction Season.
