# **Project Description:**

This project includes the construction of a new 462 ft long, single lane bridge, the creation of 18 stations of new roadway alignment, the removal of the existing bridge, and the obliteration of the existing roadway approaches.

## **Current Construction Activities**

June 19. 2025

Hamilton Construction recently completed the installation of bridge abutment #1 (west side). Construction continues on the temporary work bridge, which is on the critical path for timely project completion. This work is expected to take approximately 3-4 weeks.

## **Upcoming Construction Activities**

Upon the work bridge completion, there will be two primary work activities occurring concurrently. The installation of the two drilled shafts for piers 2 and 3 (10' Diameter) which will be drilled and excavated followed by the placement of reinforcing steel and concrete. Simultaneously, construction of the Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) Wall will occur at abutment 4 (east side) before the bridge

abutment can be installed.
