Our Office has received and reviewed the above referenced project in accordance with 54 USC 306108 (commonly known as Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, as amended), 36 CFR Part 800: Protection of Historic Properties and the Programmatic Agreement executed in 2016, as amended.

After a careful review of the submitted documentation, we concur with your finding that the proposed undertaking meets the criteria of adverse effect. The U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration in coordination with the U.S. Forest Service, will need to consult further with the SHPO to develop and evaluate alternatives or modifications to the undertaking that could avoid, minimize or mitigate adverse effects on historic properties, as per 36 CFR § 800.6.
