### **Project Description**

Utilizing Great American Outdoor Act Funding, the Lewis River Bridge project, located along the South Entrance Road, includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, excavation, and paving.

### **Work Schedule**



The contractor continues to work on final completion items like final grading, pavilion rail installation, and project clean up. They are doing stone masonry work on the south wall and guardwall. They performed some asphalt milling in preparation for final asphalt placement. Permanent traffic signs are installed.

Upcoming work includes: South wall and guardwall stonework, asphalt paving, and striping.
