This project includes the construction of a new 462 ft single lane bridge, the creation of 18 stations of new roadway alignment, the removal of the existing bridge, and the obliteration of the existing roadway approaches.

Current Construction Activities

October 24, 2025

The 2025 construction season is rapidly approaching winter shutdown, as the final phases of the bridge foundation construction nears completion. Abutments 1 & 4 are completed and Piers 2 & 3 are in the final stages of construction.

Upcoming Construction Activities

In the weeks ahead, crews will place falsework, reinforcing steel and structural concrete for the Column Pier Caps 2 & 3. Concurrently, Hamilton's team is making final preparations and attending to final punch-list and clean-up work prior to the winter shutdown. Truck traffic will also continue along the Pishkun Road for the next several weeks for the delivery of construction materials and the demobilization of project equipment and infrastructure to conclude the 2025 construction season. The project is scheduled to recommence in mid-April 2026.

Delays and Closures: (Thank you for your patience.)

Possible minor traffic delays for work occurring near the new road alignment with road closures of up to 20 minutes.



Between 7/23/25 and 11/15/25 the construction zone will be extremely active and dangerous to the public. ACCORDINGLY, THE ENTIRE CONSTRUCTION ZONE IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC AND TO ALL RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES. THIS AREA INCLUDES THE SUN RIVER 500' ABOVE AND BELOW THE NEW BRIDGE (FWP MAR NOTICE NO. 2025-301.1)

Walk-in access is permitted above and below the construction zone and additional signed boat access is available a few miles below the zone.


