Current Construction Activities

In the past few weeks, the Contractor has installed all of the bridge intermediate diaphragms between the girders and continued concrete finishing work on all exterior concrete surfaces.

Upcoming Construction Activities

The Contractor will continue to focus on critical bridge elements, including concrete bridge girder splicing, girder post-tensioning, and other related bridge work. Truck traffic will continue along Pishkin and Sun Canyon Roads as equipment and materials are delivered to and removed from the project site.

Possible minor traffic delays for work occurring near the new road alignment with road closures of up to 20 minutes.



Between 4/15/26 and 10/31/26 the construction zone will be extremely active and dangerous to the public. **ACCORDINGLY, THE ENTIRE CONSTRUCTION ZONE IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC AND TO ALL RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES. THIS AREA INCLUDES THE SUN RIVER 500' ABOVE AND BELOW THE NEW BRIDGE (FWP MAR NOTICE NO. 2025-301.1).**

Walk-in access is permitted above and below the construction zone and additional signed boat access is available a few miles below the work-zone.
