Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Contractor has been working on removing the pavement on Lathrop Street and hauling it away. The woven geotextile fabric and subbase installation at the motorized boat launch is underway. Upcoming, the contractor plans to begin excavating, widening and rebuilding Lathrop between the railroad crossing and the levee.

Traffic Closures

There will be a single lane closure on Lathrop Street between the railroad crossing and the levee, watch for flaggers.

Full closure of the Motorized Boat Launch and Parking Area M-F; west half of the Swim Beach Parking Area. Look for notices posted at parking areas with information about upcoming closures. Be mindful of construction operations on site.
