## Project Description

Located on the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, roadway excavation, and paving.

## Work Schedule

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.



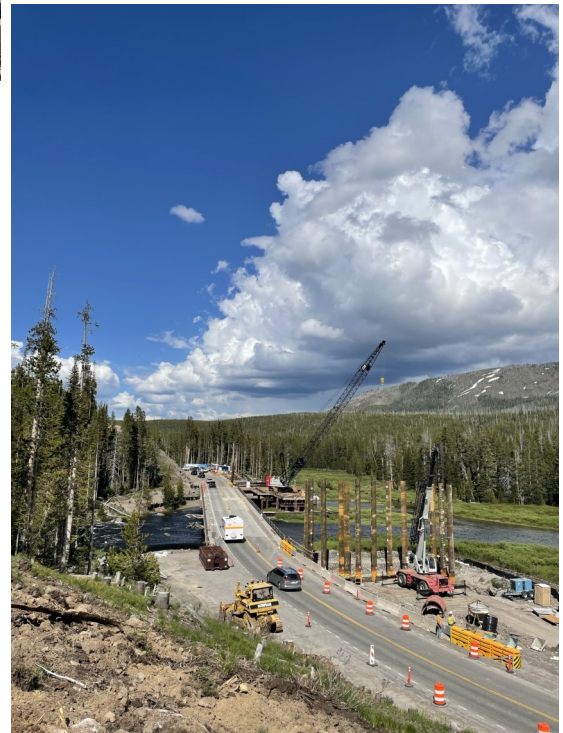
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This week the contractor finished cleaning out steel pipe piles in the pier and splicing abutment 1 piles. They began forming the concrete footings in the abutment 2 piles. They are excavating the North slope.

Upcoming work includes: driving steel pipe piles in abutment 1, placing concrete in pier piles, and doing concrete form work. They will be blasting the North slope and excavating it.

## Traffic Delays

Anticipate up to 15 minute delays during construction activities. There will be a one-lane, two-way temporary traffic control zone
