08/11/2020 – Finish running cables under the bridge. Set Safespan sheeting in laydown areas near bridge. (No traffic delays expected)

08/12/2020 – Traffic control starts and will take one lane at a time, no traffic delays longer than 15 min. We will begin lowering the Safespan sheeting over the side of the bridge and fastening to the cables for the work platform floor. (Traffic Control 7:00-5:30)

08/13/2020 - Traffic control will take one lane at a time, no traffic delays longer than 15 min. We will lower Safespan sheeting over the side and fasten to the cables for the work platform floor. (Traffic Control 7:00-5:30)

08/14/2020 - Traffic control will take one lane at a time, no traffic delays longer than 15 min. We will lower Safespan sheeting over the side and fasten to the cables for the work platform floor. (Traffic Control 7:00-5:30)

8/15/2020 - Traffic control will take one lane at a time, no traffic delays longer than 15 min. We will lower Safespan sheeting over the side and fasten to the cables for the work platform floor. (Traffic Control 7:00-5:30)
