## Project Description

Located on the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, roadway excavation, and paving.



## Work Schedule

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 6 - 7 days a week.



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This week the contractor is forming and setting rebar in the abutment 1 walls. Excavation is being done in preparation for building the MSE wall at abutment 2 along with placing special rock embankment at the new Falls View Trail.

Upcoming work includes: forming and placing concrete in abutment 1 walls. Backfilling will commence around abutment 2 and the MSE wall will be built as work continues on the rock embankment along the Falls View Trail.



## Traffic Delays

Anticipate up to 15 minute delays during construction activities. There will be a one-lane, two-way temporary traffic control zone. Be aware of stop lights for trucks entering the road at the South Pit.
