## **Project Description**



This project is located in Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Skamania County, Washington. The scope of work for this project is to repair roadway sites that were damaged during a large storm event in 2016. The project is using Emergency Relief for Federally Owned Roads funding to repair the sites.

The following eight (8) Forest Service (USFS) sites are included in this project:

The crew is working at RD 2900 MP 7.6, Camp Creek is still diverted but flowing through the placed 84" pipe culvert. The 170 foot long 84" pipe culvert and concrete pre-cast cut-off head and end walls have been fully installed. Back fill continues to be placed. The site is passible by construction equipment. The diversion at Scamp Creek, RD 2900 MP 9.3, is ready. The installation of two 72" pipe culverts with precast concrete cut-off head walls and a conjoined concrete cutoff end wall will begin next week.





National Forest Development Road 2900 closed at MP 4. Anticipated reopening date: October 20, 2020.
