Project Description

(A)

This project is located in Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Skamania County, Washington. The scope of work for this project is to repair roadway sites that were damaged during a large storm event in 2016. The project is using Emergency

Relief for Federally Owned Roads funding to repair the sites.

The following eight (8) Forest Service (USFS) sites are included in this project:

RD 2900 MP 7.6 RD 2900 MP 9.3 RD 2900 MP 10.2 RD 2900 MP 10.4 RD 2500 MP 25 RD 2900 MP 10.4 RD 9000 MP 45

LKE, Corp. is working at RD 2900 MP 7.6, Camp Creek has been diverted and LKE is installing a pipe culvert with concrete pre-cast cut-off head and end walls. Once this section is passable with construction equipment, LKE will divert water at Scamp Creek, RD 2900 MP 9.3, and begin preparation for installation of two pipe culverts with precast concrete cut-off head walls and a conjoined concrete cut-off end wall.

The concrete pre-cast cut-off walls are installed as of Wednesday, July 22nd at RD 2900 MP 7.6. LKE is currently installing and backfilling the 170' long x 84" diameter pipe culvert.
