The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Office of Civil Rights is in receipt of your letter and accompanying documents dated August 24, 2010, which were received in this office on October 26, 2010. In your letter, you indicate that you want to file a complaint against the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) regarding the on-going issue of the repair of a driveway. The documentation you provided includes a citation filed by the TxDOT stating that you negligently caused damage to property belonging to the TxDOT.

After reviewing the information you provided, the FHWA has determined that we do not have jurisdiction over the issue you are raising. You will need to continue working with the TxDOT and the court system to resolve your concerns.
