This is in reference to the complaint of discrimination you filed against the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) alleging a violation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Your complaint was forwarded to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) by the TxDOT on June 10, 2010. The FHWA notified you of its receipt of your complaint by letter dated August 25, 2010.

During a telephone interview with you on September 10, 2010, you informed me that a representative from the TxDOT met with you and made a commitment to correct the issue cited in your complaint. Based on that commitment, you have agreed to withdraw your complaint of discrimination.

Since the TxDOT is taking the necessary action to correct the issue cited in your complaint and you are satisfied with that effort, the FHWA will close the complaint and take no further action.
