Dear **(b) (6)**:

This letter is in reference to your complaint received by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) on April 11, 2014. In your complaint, you allege that the Nevada Department of Transportation discriminated against you because of your age, in violation of the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI). Specifically, you allege that the Nevada Department of Transportation impounded your automobile in a discriminatory fashion.

FHWA is responsible for investigating individual complaints of discrimination involving violations of Title VI, pursuant to 23 CFR Part 200. After a thorough review of your allegation, we have determined that FHWA does not have jurisdiction to investigate your complaint and will dismiss it.

This concludes the processing of your complaint by the FHWA Office of Civil Rights.

Please note that **(b) (6)** may file a complaint with the US Department of Justice pursuant to 28 CFR Part 42.408. **(b) (6)** may also file a private suit at any time pursuant to section 603 of Title VI, regardless of whether FHWA finds a violation.
