

EASTERN FEDERAL LANDS ACCESS PROGRAM

The Programming Decisions Committee (PDC) responsible for the District of Columbia Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) has selected its initial, multiyear Program of Projects. The projects identified for programming for the District of Columbia FLAP are listed below in no particular order and include:

The next step in the process will be to develop project agreements between Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division and the State/Local Agency partners. The amount of funds allocated will depend on finalizing these project agreements. Funding for these projects is not guaranteed. Funding beyond 2014 is dependent on reauthorization of the Access Program by Congress. The District of Columbia PDC does not have a firm date for the next call for projects under the Access Program, but another call is anticipated within the next year.
