

1 STATE SPECIFIC NPDES REQUIREMENTS:

Below is a summary for NPDES permitting within states within FHWA-CFLHD's division boundary. Each state permit is normally issued for a period of 5 years. However, some states are not able to meet the 5-year deadline to re-issue the permits and administratively extend the permits until the new permit can be issued. Additional details for each state can be found detailed in their respective permits and regulatory agency websites.
