Lewis River Bridge Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Project Description

Located on the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, roadway excavation, and paving.

Expect work 1:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 6 - 7 days a week.



Upcoming work includes: cleaning out the steel pipe piles in abutment 1 and finish placing concrete in pier piles. They will continue blasting and excavating the North slope. Haul trucks are expected during the night between the project site and South Entrance Pit.

Traffic Delays

Anticipate up to 15 minute delays during construction activities. There will be a one -lane, two-way temporary traffic control zone. This week the contractor placed concrete in the abutment 2 footing and pier piles. They are driving the steel pipe piles in abutment 1. They continue excavating the North slope and drilling in preparation for the 3rd blast.
