# Traffic Delays

Anticipate up to 15 minute delays during construction activities. There will be a one -lane, two-way temporary traffic control zone

# **Project Description**

Located on the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, roadway excavation, and paving.

### **Work Schedule**

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.



This week the contractor is cleaning out steel pipe piles in abutment 2 and filling them with concrete. They are cutting and welding piles in abutment 1.

Upcoming work includes: reviewing blasting plans and schedule, driving steel pipe piles in abutment 1, placing concrete in abutment 2 piles, cleaning out pier piles, concrete form work, and installing rebar.
