Project Description

Located along the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, roadway excavation and paving.

Work Schedule

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 6—7 days a week.



This past week the contractor continued construction of the south shoulder and began construction of the South MSE Wall, while beginning to pack up for the season by hauling away equipment.. The girder erection subcontractor continued girder erection by

setting and splicing girders onto Abutment 2.

Upcoming work includes: finishing girder erection by welding girders to bearings, continuing construction of the North and South MSE Walls, and continuation of hauling away equipment.
