

## Work in the Mohave Begins Next Week February 11, 2020

## CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc. is set to begin work on the Pavement Preservation Manzanar project on Tuesday, February 18th.

After preliminary meetings which include Park Orientation and Tortoise training on the morning of the 18th, they will begin striping the 56 miles of Route 10, Kelbaker Road which is scheduled to take 9 days to complete.

The schedule then has the striping taking place in the following order:

Route 18, Essex Road

Route 17, Black Canyon Road

Route 14, Ivanpah Road

Route 13, Morning Star Mine Road

Route 12, Cima Road

Route 11, Kelso-Cima Road

Routes 906, 900, & 907, Parking Areas

The work at Manzanar NHS is scheduled to begin on March 16th.
