CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Intermountain Slurry Seal, (ISS) took advantage of the President's Day holiday to mobilize to Baker, California in preparation for the project.

Tuesday, FHWA and Intermountain received informative Tortoise Training and Mojave National Preserve orientation and then the work began.

The first 20 miles of Kelbaker Road east of Baker was striped in the first week. Its amazing how the new lines makes the whole road "pop".

Work on Kelbaker will continue through next week with work on Essex Road beginning on Friday. The work at Manzanar NHS is scheduled to begin on March 16th.
