Intermountain completed Kelbaker Road two days ahead of schedule and moved over to Essex and Black Canyon Roads on Wednesday afternoon

Next week, the plan is to work on Ivanpah Rd. on Monday, Morning Star Rd. Tuesday thru Thursday, and then Cima and Kelso Cima Roads on Thursday and Friday.

The work at Manzanar NHS is scheduled to begin on March 16th.
