Striping the Mojave Nears the End

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Intermountain had planned to halt work in the Mojave and move to and finish Manzanar before completing the striping in late April. Change in plans, Mojave will be finished this week before heading over to Manzanar.

Striping schedule for the week of 3/23/2020:

Monday—Morning Star Mine Road

Tuesday—Cima Road

Wednesday—Cima and Kelso-Cima Roads

Thursday / Friday—Parking Areas, Symbols, and Punchlist Items.

Manzanar work begins on March 30th with sealing and filling cracks in preparation for micro surfacing. Expect partial closures during the week of April 6.
