Construction Activities

Work at Forest Service Road (FSR) 4010-050 MP 0.78 and MP 2.3 will continue next week. At MP 2.3 the contractor will be working on finishing the roadway grade. At MP 0.78 the backfilling and streambed material placement is well underway and should be completed next week. At both MP 0.78 and MP 2.3 the contractor anticipates starting placement of the roadway aggregate before the end of next week. FSR 4010-050 is closed to public traffic during the work at MP 0.78 and MP 2.3.

Work at FSR 4200/FSR 4200-400 MP 0.2 is now complete. FSR 4200-400 will remain closed as part of the seasonally established USFS road closures for the area (See USFS - Tonasket Ranger District website for more information).

Project seeding will get underway next week. The sites marked with a star on the map below show which sites will get seeded. It is anticipated that this work will take the first half of next week to complete. Limited delays to public traffic are expected as the crew works at each site, completing the seeding. No road closures are expected as part of this work. FSR 4010-050 MP 0.78 and MP 2.3 may have the seeding delayed to the end of the week to allow more time for finish work at both sites.


