Construction Activities

Work at Forest Service Road (FSR) 4010-050 MP 0.78 and MP 2.3 will finish next week. At both MP 0.78 and MP 2.3 the contractor will be completing the placement of roadway aggregate and grading of the roadway by the end of the week. It is anticipated that final cleanup and demobilization of equipment will also be completed before the end of next week.

Following the completion of the work at FSR 4010-050 next week, FSR 4010-050 will remain closed as part of the seasonally established USFS road closures for the area (See USFS - Methow Valley Ranger District website for more information).

Seeding at FSR 4010-050 MP 0.78 & MP 2.3 - Woody Creek Road, is scheduled to be completed on Monday, November 2nd.

Seeding was completed this past week at the following project sites:
FSR 3300-100 MP 8.9 - Spur Mountain Road
FSR 4150 MP 0.3 & MP 2.2 - Benson Creek Road
FSR 4415-040 MP 0.0 to 0.4 - Cow Creek Road
FSR 5008-100 MP 0.75 - Bear Creek Road
FSR 5140 MP 10.2 - Falls Creek Road



Please, if the closed signs are up, stay out of the work area.


Also, use caution on roads nearby these sites, as there will be increased traffic related to work activities and road conditions are also quick to change with the winter season weather condition in the area.
