Idaho Centennial Trail/Wyoming Teton Pass Centennial Trail Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

The Idaho Centennial Trail/Wyoming Teton Pass Centennial Trail project consists of constructing a paved non-motorized pathway from the Moose Creek bridge to Trail Creek Campground and includes the construction of a new bridge and two underpasses. Highways ID 33/WY 22 will remain open until August 15th, but drivers should be aware of vehicles entering and exiting the roadway. Lane closures will begin Aug. 15th. The Old Jackson Highway and Rush Hour trail is closed to all traffic at Moose Creek Bridge, including pedestrian and bicycle. Pedestrians and cyclists are recommended to drive directly to trailhead parking areas. Heavy equipment is in operation along various parts of the trail, and the process of removal of the Moose Creek bridge has begun, presenting possible hazardous conditions for any unauthorized persons entering the project.
